

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS CMAQ PROJECT C5118
CITY OF LEXINGTON, NORTH CAROLINA**

Pursuant to Section 143-129 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, sealed proposals for the construction of "**Sidewalk Improvements CMAQ Project C5118**" will be received on or before **2:00pm on Wednesday, June 2, 2010, in the Council Chambers at Lexington City Hall, 28 W. Center Street, Lexington, NC 27292**, at which time the proposals will be publicly opened and read.

The construction work will consist of approximately 3,725 feet of 5' Concrete Sidewalk, and Wheelchair Ramps.

Proposals must be sealed and marked "**Sidewalk Improvements CMAQ Project C5118**". All proposals must be submitted upon the blank forms provided in the copies of Proposal, Contract, and Specifications. The Bids for this proposed work will be received at the City of Lexington, Attn: Britt Smith, Purchasing Officer, 28 West Center Street, Lexington, NC 27292.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at the City of Lexington Council Chambers in City Hall, 28 W. Center St., Lexington, NC 27292 for all Bidders on **Wednesday, May 19, 2010 at 2:00pm**. This conference is to allow Bidders an opportunity to present questions, obtain clarifications and inspect the project site. Attendance at the Pre-Bid Conference is highly recommended.

Each bid must be accompanied by Bid security in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the Bid. Security may be in the form of cash, a certified check made payable to the City of Lexington, North Carolina and drawn on a bank or trust company insured under the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, or a Bidder's Bond.

Contract Documents may be obtained upon application to the Engineer, Davis-Martin-Powell & Associates, Inc., 6415 Old Plank Road, High Point, North Carolina, 27265, (336) 886-4821, upon payment of a \$50.00 non-refundable deposit. Documents are on file at the office of the Associated General Contractors (High Point, Charlotte, Raleigh); Dodge Plan Room (Charlotte); City of Lexington Public Works office; and the office of the Engineer.

Consideration will be given only to NC DOT prequalified general and subcontractors.

Both a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond are required in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract price, conditioned upon the faithful performance of the Contract and upon the payment in full to all persons supplying labor and furnishing materials for and in connection with the construction of the project.

The City of Lexington reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all bids.
